OUR GUILD IS 30 NEXT YEAR – Three decades strong!

In 1994, the Texas Shakespeare Festival was in its 9th season. Forwardthinking Festival lovers founded the Guild to ensure the Festival's future beyond its first decade and the generous support of Kilgore College.

Guiding the Development Committee were Delisa Barbee, Sue Brown, Amanda Nobles, Martha Rorschach, and Ellen Watson. Their efforts gave life to the non-profit TSF Foundation, organized to raise funds, and its Guild Committee, organized to

raise friends and volunteers.

They launched a Guild membership drive in fall 1994, and 391 individuals from 25 Texas cities and 4 states responded--our charter members.

The Development Committee also recruited 31 additional volunteers to lead the board and committees during 1994 and 1995.

In 2024, the Guild and Foundation will celebrate their 30th anniversary. We invite you to join us in honoring our Charter members, of whom 64 individuals from 8 Texas cities and 3 states are still loyal Guild supporters.

As we celebrate the 30th for the Guild, we will also ask Guild members, 1994-2024 to share your fondest TSF memories in anticipation of the Texas Shakespeare Festival's 40th anniversary season in 2025!

Get your stories ready; we want to revisit the Guild's birth AND its growth to maturity. There are bound to be some good tales to be told!

Wine & Wassail—SOLD OUT!


